Does your organization align with the following grant funding priorities?

Programs are Christ-centered and align with core values.

The Foundation partners with nonprofit organizations demonstrating effective Christian evangelism, mobilizing volunteers, and long-term impact.

Established as a 501(c)(3) non-profit in good standing.

The Foundation distributes grants only to qualified public entities or organizations exempt from tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Strong and effective Board of Directors.

The Foundation seeks organizations with active board of directors that demonstrate strong and decisive leadership.

Launching a new program mobilizing volunteers to serve and evangelize.

The Foundation prioritizes organizations with a desire to grow and expand God's Kingdom for long-term impact. New projects or expansion plans that demonstrate greater efficiency over time and a clear path to measurable results are ideal qualities for a ministry partner.

Program and request align with grant cycle dates.

Grant cycles begin at the start of every calendar quarter after the decision to approve has been made. A full grant term consists of 12 months. For current ministry partners, the Foundation will not consider a new request until the grant term has been completed.

International partnerships are selective and limited.

International requests are chosen on a selective basis and organizations are contacted to apply directly by the Foundation. International online inquiries are not considered.
